RECOMMENDED CLASSES & RULES

TRACTOR, ANTIQUE RULES

TRACTOR ELIGIBILITY:

1. Tractors eligible are Antique original or restored models built prior to 1960, with fenders.
2. Tractor models built during and after 1960 must submit to a serial number check.
3. Rear rim size must remain original.
4. Tires to be available rear farm tires only.
5. Loaded rear tires and two rear wheel weights per side allowed.
6. Loaded front tires and one front wheel weight per side allowed.
7. 20-inch maximum drawbar height. No less than 18 inches from rear axle center.
8. No wire on the governor or modified throttle linkage(s).
9. PTO speed not to exceed 700rpm.
10. Rear antique tire sizes must have been available prior to 1960, 2 sizes over MFG.
11. No loaders, no pistons or loader arms, sub frames allowed only.
12. Tractors are allowed Class pull and One Step Up Pull only.
13. HP pull rating by North American Nebraska Test with 0.5 (point 5) grace.
14. Weigh pulls 3,500 through 11,500 and farm tractors.

SAFETY:

1. No alcoholic beverage consumption by drivers until completion of their competition.
2. Driver to remain seated during pull.
3. Pull must start with a tight chain.
4. Two hook attempts allowed if first attempt does not exceed 75 feet. (Attempt stop at 75 feet acceptable).
5. Lift and carry of front end with more than 3 feet of clearance under front tires is end of pull-pull counts. (If less than 75 feet, second attempt still allowed).
6. Decisions are final. In case of conflict, Track officials may examine and rule on decision.
7. All weights must be securely fastened. If weight falls off on red flag (end of pull) pull still counts.
