

4x4 Stock Truck Rules

1. Stock Trucks, this includes original engines for the vehicle.
2. Tires must be STREET legal, off road or paddle tires will not be permitted.
3. Truck Hitch Height may not exceed 26 inches.
4. Clean Boxes: box of vehicle or passenger compartment may not contain any ballast.
5. Only the operator may be in the vehicle while pulling, no passengers.
6. Classes will be $\frac{1}{2}$ ton, $\frac{3}{4}$ ton and 1 ton.
7. A $\frac{1}{2}$ ton is a vehicle with 6 (six) or less wheel studs.
8. No fuel additives, nitrous etc.
9. If the competitor does not exceed 75 feet in his/her first attempt he/she may try again and their second pull will be their measured pull.
10. While pulling the competitor must obey the flagman, failure to do this may result in disqualification.
11. If there is a protest/complaint against a competing vehicle the final decision will be made by NLAS officials.
12. Reckless driving before, during or after your pull may lead to disqualification.
